Branch 13

Branch 13 is a small branch headed by Richard and Agnes Braund née Woodman, who married in Germansweek, Devon in 1796. They had five children before Richard was buried in nearby Northlew ten years later. Richard and Agnes' marriage record says that Richard was from Bratton Clovelly but that does not help to identify him. There is a possible Richard in branch 3 whose future is unaccounted for but he would only have been about seventeen at the time of the marriage and there is no indication that the Richard who married Agnes Woodman was underage. Unfortunately, the marriage witnesses are no help either.

It has also been difficult to trace Richard and Agnes' descendants. Only the youngest daughter, Sarah, has a line that we have been able to carry forward to the present day. Her descendants settled in Canada. Susan Hill née Braund's emigration story can be found on the Braund Stories page.
