

Branch 14

Branch 14 is a small branch that is a bit of a mystery. It begins with the baptism of William, son of Humphrey and Frances Braund, or Brawn, in Cookbury, Devon in 1804. There seems to be no other children of this couple and no marriage for Humphrey and Frances. Frances is buried in Cookbury in 1839 but there is no sign of Humphrey.

Branch 14 descendants spread to London. Cambridgeshire, Gloucestershire and Canada.

DNA has not helped to suggested how branch 14 may be linked to other Braund branches.
